



# A scholarship in honour of the 'Polish children and caregivers of Pahīatua' \$2,000

This scholarship commemorates the arrival in 1944 of the 733 Polish children and their mainly female caregivers who, initially deported from Eastern Poland to Siberia during World War II, were invited by the NZ government to stay in Pahīatua, Manawatū.

Many of these children, mostly orphans, remained in NZ when they could not return to Poland, building new lives in their 'paradise'.

Recognising women committed to community engagement or cultural preservation, this scholarship is intended to assist a female student, who will be enrolling full-time at an approved tertiary institute in the Auckland or Northland region in 2026.



# Interested in learning more about Polish people in New Zealand?

The first "brilliant but cranky" Pole arrived in Dusky Sound with his son in March 1773 with Captain Cook's ship, Resolution.

During the next 100 years, mostly single men—adventurers—followed, but it was not till 1872 that the first significant groups of Polish families arrived, and started their lives in a land that was as foreign to them as they were to it.
